Speakers Announced for Court History Symposium

Second Annual CLE Forum on November 6

INDIANAPOLIS (October 12, 2009) — The second annual "Court History Symposium: Court History and History in the Making" will be presented on Friday, November 6, 2009, at the Birch Bayh Federal Building and United States Court House, 46 East Ohio Street.

Sponsored by the Historical Society of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana, the three-hour Continuing Legal Education forum (approval of credit pending) will be held in the William E. Steckler Ceremonial Courtroom (Room 202) from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

The event will feature presentations from:

- Dr. Elizabeth Monroe, who will speak on what federal territorial materials reveal about the early practice of law in Indiana.
- Indiana Supreme Court Chief Justice Randall T. Shepard, a frequent speaker on legal history.
- A repeat of the successful judicial roundtable event from last year's CLE with a panel of judges from the Southern District.

The event will conclude with an informal reception outside the courtroom, with refreshments provided.
