**NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER**

The Court, on its own motion, issues this order *nunc pro tunc* to supplement its Confidentiality Order dated March 7, 2001 (“Confidentiality Order”). Section 6 of the Confidentiality Order is hereby amended to provide as follows:

6. Filing Under Seal Confidential Materials, when filed with the Court, shall be filed under seal. Such filings shall be placed in a sealed envelope with an attached label containing the caption of this case, the title of the filing, and the words “FILED UNDER SEAL ACCORDING TO CONFIDENTIALITY ORDER.” Counsel for Intervenors shall be served with a copy of the above-described label only and not with a copy of the document filed under seal. Documents filed under seal in this manner will remain under seal for fourteen days, at which time the seal will be automatically lifted, subject to the following procedure: Within five days

of the filing under seal, the party who has designated the sealed document(s) confidential may file a motion requesting that the Court continue to maintain the filing under seal. That motion (which itself cannot be filed under seal and must be served upon counsel for Intervenors) must include a description of the Confidential Materials sufficient to enable any party or Intervenor to evaluate the assertion of confidentiality and frame a response. Any party or Intervenor opposing that request shall have five days to respond in writing. When this procedure is invoked, the seal will not be automatically lifted but will remain in effect until further order of the Court.
