The plaintiffs and defendant Ford Motor Company appeared, by counsel, this date for a hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion to Enforce the Court's Entries Regarding Production of Ford Databases. The magistrate judge heard the arguments of counsel and the presentations of the parties' experts, consulted with her technical advisor, and also had informal discussions with counsel and the experts to determine whether all or part of the dispute could be resolved amicably.
