ENTRY FOR MARCH 25, 2002

In the Entry for March 20, 2002, the magistrate judge set forth the schedule for the deposition of William Clay Ford, Jr., which is scheduled for March 27-28, 2002. The schedule set forth in that Entry was in error, in that it neglected to include time for defendant Bridgestone Corporation to depose Mr. Ford. The schedule as revised to include Bridgestone Corporation is as follows:

1. The state court plaintiffs will have nine hours to conduct their direct examination, to be divided as follows:
 - a. 6.5 hours for the Texas plaintiffs (including the Texas Ford dealers)
 - b. 1.5 hours for the Arizona, Florida, and Tennessee plaintiffs; and
 - c. 1 hour for the California plaintiffs.
2. The MDL plaintiffs will have three hours to conduct their direct examination, which will be divided equally between the class action plaintiffs and the personal injury plaintiffs.
3. Firestone and Bridgestone Corporation will have one hour, to be allocated at their discretion, to conduct their direct examinations.
4. Ford waives its time for cross examination.
5. All of the plaintiffs, both state and MDL, will have 1 hour total for redirect.
