Terre Haute Federal Courthouse Relocation Scheduled for August 24, 2009

On Monday, August 24, 2009, the Terre Haute Division of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana will permanently relocate from its current home to a new federal courthouse located at 921 Ohio Street, Terre Haute, Indiana, 47807. New phone numbers will also go into effect on August 24, 2009, as follows:

The federal courts have maintained a presence in Terre Haute since 1925, and the court is moving out of the historic main post office building, located at 30 North Seventh Street in downtown Terre Haute. The postal service is handing over the building to Indiana State University for use as its School of Business.

The Division will have limited operations on Friday, August 21, at the 30 North Seventh Street location as the move takes place.

The new federal courthouse will house both the U. S. District Court and U. S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Indiana, as well as the U. S. Probation Office. The U. S. Attorney's Office and United States Marshals Service will also have space within the building.

The new courthouse features a classically-styled courtroom and hearing room, shared clerk's office, and other office space. The courtroom, judge's chambers, and hearing room will be outfitted with refurbished tables, benches, chairs, and desks from the current courthouse, providing the new building with a link to the past.
