GENERAL ORDER

After due consideration, the Court has determined that applying the amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure governing appeals, Rules 8001 to 8028, to pending bankruptcy appeals would not be practicable because of the difficulty and unfairness that would be created by altering the rules applicable to a case, particularly rules that may impact deadlines for filings. Accordingly, the Court now ORDERS that amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 8001 to 8028, effective December 1, 2014, shall apply only to bankruptcy appeals in this Court as to which the notice of appeal is filed on or after December 1, 2014.
