## **ORDER**

WHEREAS, the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts has established a Registry Fee to be assessed for administration of funds held in the registry of the court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2041 and placed in interest-bearing accounts or instruments;

WHEREAS such Registry Fee is authorized and set forth in the Judicial Conference Policy Notes appended to 28 U.S.C. § 1914, under the heading "Registry Fun Fees - Item 13";

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, that the Clerk of Court shall deduct from income earned on registry funds invested in interest-bearing accounts or instruments, a fee not exceeding that authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States and set by the Director of the Administrative Office in accordance with the schedule which shall be published periodically by the Director in the Federal Register. The fee shall be withdrawn whenever income earned becomes available for deduction and shall be deposited in the United States Treasury without further order of the court. This assessment shall apply to all registry funds invested in interest-bearing accounts held outside the United States Treasury.
