Because the plaintiff is a "prisoner" as defined by 28 U.S.C. § 1915 (h), this Court has an obligation under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) to screen his complaint before service on the defendants. First, all claims against Warden D. Fender are dismissed because the complaint contains no factual allegations against D. Fender. Second, all claims against Marion County Jail 1 are dismissed because the jail is not a "person" subject to suit pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Third, all claims against Wexford are dismissed. Because the Court has been unable to identify a viable claim for relief against any particular defendant, the complaint is subject to dismissal. The dismissal of the complaint will not in this instance lead to the dismissal of the action at present. Instead, the plaintiff shall have through December 17, 2018, in which to file an amended complaint. Because the plaintiff did not have access to the defendant's address, he could not serve his motion on her. The Court has sent the defendant a copy of the plaintiff's motion by separate Entry and given her a deadline by which to respond. Apart from the motion for entry of default judgment, the plaintiff has filed numerous motions related to the defendant's failure to timely answer the complaint and the plaintiff's demand for damages. The plaintiff's motion for damages, dkt. <a href="#">49</a> , motion for court order, dkt. <a href="#">50</a> , and motion for judgment, dkt. <a href="#">51</a> , are denied as duplicative of the plaintiff's motion filed on July 19, 2019. Dkt. 48. The plaintiff shall refrain from filing duplicative motions in the future. When the plaintiff files a motion on a particular issue, the defendant has a period of time - at least 14 days - in which to respond. If she responds, the plaintiff may file a reply. Once the motion is ripe for review, the Court will decide the motion in due course. It does not assist the Court or the litigants to file additional motions that restate the same issue already raised in a pending motion. In addition, the plaintiff's motion for requests for admissions, dkt. <a href="#">46</a> , is denied as premature. The Court will enter a scheduling order after the defendant files an answer. The scheduling order will include deadlines for serving discovery requests, such as requests to admit, on the defendant. Such requests are not filed with the Court. In sum, the Court has denied plaintiff's motions at dockets 46, 49, 50, and 51. The plaintiff's motions at dockets 47 and 48 remain pending. The Court will rule on the pending motions after either the defendant has responded and the plaintiff has replied, or the time to do so has passed. The plaintiff shall not file additional motions regarding the defendants' failure to answer and the plaintiff's demand for damages unless instructed to do so by the Court.
