Bukowski, 800 F.3d 392, 394 (7th Cir. 2015); Pavey v. Conley, 544 F.3d 739, 742 (7th Cir. 2008), striking the defense if it lacks an adequate factual basis will expedite resolution of this action. Ms. Hamblen will have through September 9, 2022, to file a notice identifying the factual basis for the affirmative defense that the plaintiff failed to exhaust his administrative remedies. Alternatively, she may file a notice withdrawing the defense. The failure to pursue either of these options by the above deadline constitutes an abandonment of the exhaustion defense. He will complete and return the form or notify the Court that he wishes to continue without a lawyer no later than March 15, 2024. If Mr. Greer takes no action in the time provided, the Court will attempt to recruit counsel for him in accordance with the conditions noted on page 4 of the form motion. See Order.
