AMENDED GENERAL ORDER

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana establishes the following threshold number of appearances that will be used to determine which attorneys are eligible for the Obligatory Panel created pursuant to S.D. Indiana Local Rule 87. This number is established based on the need for representation in a given year.

The threshold number of appearances entered in 2015 to be eligible for the Obligatory Panel in 2016 was 10.

The threshold number of appearances entered in 2016 to be eligible for the Obligatory Panel in 2017 was 5.

The threshold number of appearances to qualify for the Obligatory Panel in all subsequent calendar years is 4. This number may be adjusted by way of future General Order.
